#### Review of Implementation of previous decisions

- The Secretary to the Board explained the implementation status of the decisions taken in the Board Meeting held on 18-5-1998 where, out of 23 items, action had been initiated in 19 cases. Regarding regularization of services of daily wages employees (7.2) F.A/Member informed that Personnel Directorate was compiling the requisite information on a proforma devised by Finance Wing. Regarding 7.3 to grant status of regular employees to regular (P) employees the Board was informed that since the Director Personnel had retired on 8-6-1998 the matter could not proceed. The Chairman observed that the new Director Personnel is in position and the Committee should now complete the task in two weeks. The Chairman emphasized early implementation of the decisions taken in the Board Meetings and directed that in future the implementation report should be circulated along with the agenda items for consideration in the Board meeting.

7.2 Explosive Magazine in Sector H-11, Islamabad.

The Board decided that as recommended by the Honourable Wafaqi Mohtasib the complainant may be allowed conversion of land use for the purpose of of an institution as per land use criteria in H series subject to payment of conversion charges to be fixed by the Planning Wing.

The Board also decided that Member (Planning) should re-examine the amendments in section 14(A) to (M) of the CDA Land Disposal Regulation being made part of the CDA Ordinance and submit a report within two weeks.

7.7 Restoration of Plot No. 1-A, Class-III, Shopping Centre in Sector G-8/4-2, Islamabad.

The Board decided to restore the allotment subject to payment of all outstanding dues including restoration charges and delayed payment charges.

7.8 Conversion from weigh bridge to commercial plot No. 10, 1-9 Markaz. Islamabad

## Decision

The Board decided to ask the allottee to make payment of all the outstanding dues in lumpsum within a fortnight before his request for conversion is considered. After receipt of payments a fresh summary be brought before the Board. Also a report be submitted regarding the actual construction and violations, if any, at site.

The Board decided to restore the allotment subject to payment of delayed payment charges of premium, AGR, delayed payment charges of AGR and Restoration charges.

7.10 Issue of formal allotment letter in respect of Plot No. 17, Industrial Area, Sector I-10/3, Islamabad.

The Board did not approve the restoration of the offer as the plot was allotted in January 1993 and the ex-allottees had taken no steps to clear the outstanding dues and the CVT and Advance Tax

7.11 Restoration of Plot Nos. 39-40, Industrial Triangle Kahuta Road Islamabad.

## Decision

The Board decided to restore the allotment subject to payment of balance premium in three, two-monthly instalments, delayed payment charges and restoration charges.

7.12 Restoration of plot No. 417, Whole Sale (F&V) Market Sector I-11/4, Islamabad.

The Board decided that allotment may be restored subject to payment of all the dues, in lumpsum, within one month.

The Board decided not to take any piece meal decision. Director Lands and Rehabilitation should study the problem in its entirety and suggest workable package deal which should clear all such abadies in Sector G-11. He should put up recommendations and bring back fresh summary before the Board in 60 days.
