The Board felt that there was no necessity of making book adjustments for the architectural design work done by the Director Arch:, as it would involve innecessary paper work. Layout plan of Industrial Area in Sector I-10

1405/70 BF-Cord/ The summary on the captioned item was introduced by the rector Planning. The Loard approved the layout plan for northern lf sector of I-10 with the following observations :-

a) The Railway Hiding which has been proposed on extreme e of the Sector should be shifted to a more convenient site

it can serve larger number of plots than what has been by open by Since the Rail

- b) Since the Railway cannot take a turn at right angle, of land should be made for curves and thus plots reced or enlarged according to curves at the appropriate places.
- c) Some of the plots are not served by any road. The should be modified so that each industrial plot is served the road.
- d) It has been found out that number of plots carved originally in the lay out were not found on the gound and the of plots which were not included in the layout were found be on the ground. Care should, therefore, be exercised that lots should be so carved out that every inch of land is utilised.

Revised layout plan of model village near Humak at Kahuta noad was explained by the Director Planning to the Board. The goard approved the revised layout plan.

Site planning of centres in Diplomatic Enclave

The layout plan of the Shopping Centre in the Diplomatic mclav was presented before the Board by Director Planning. The Board approved the site plan of the Centre. The Shopping Centre in the Diplomatic Enclave will be commensurate with the status of the people living in it. Obviously, therefore, there will be a Class V Shopping Centre. Since advertisement had been issued for the allotment of the shoping sites care should be taken to select those parties for allotment who can construct blocks of shops and not one shop in order to ensure unity of design, facade and all other architectural details.

Design of Blue Area between Ramna_7 and Shalimar_7 Sectors

A Shalimar 7 Sectors was displayed before the Board by Mr.Remi Cazal, French Architect and Director Arch: The Board approved the work so far done, in principle. The Board, however, directed that under-passes should be so designed that these can be used either for perestrians or car crossings. The Board further impressed that the speed of work should be accelerated so that the design of the services is also completed without further delay.
