The Board observed that M/s Naqvi and Siddiqui, Architect had promised some time ago to send foundation drawings of the Parliament Building but the same had not been received to date. The Director (Arch.) was advised to get in touch with the Architect in order to expedite submission of requisite drawings. The question for creating a separate Division for the Parliament Building also came under discussion. The Director General Works was asked to examine the proposal and give his recommendation with detailed justification.

#### III. 144 A type Houses.

The Director General Works was asked to ensure completion of civil works of the 144 A type houses by August 15, 1975. The Board observed that if it was not possible to complete all the 144 A type houses by the given date, efforts should be made to complete as many houses as possible by the said date. It was also decided that an interim information in this behalf be sent to the Works Division.

#### IV. Construction of Police Station/ Posts in Islamabad.

The Director Architecture informed the Board that detailed drawings were under preparation and would be completed soon.

## IX. Construction of Additional Block in Government Hostel.

The Director Architecture informed the Board that the bifurcation drawings of Government Hostel with required additions as per directive of the Joint Committee of the Parliament had already been prepared and sent to Director General Works for preparation of estimates.

The Chairman enquired the position with regard to the design of Government Officers Hostel. Director Architecture informed that sketch design was under preparation. He was asked to complete the sketch design by 4th August, 1975 and keep it ready for presentation.

#### X. Roads.

It was noticed that figures of total expenditure on Road required to be reconciled. Director Tech. was asked to review the matter and furnish firm figures of allocation and expenditure by 4.8.1975.

#### XI. Water Supply.

The Director (Water and Sewerage) was asked to prepare an upto-date position of expenditure incurred on the water supply system on quarterly basis and furnish the same to the Board for perusal. It was observed by the Board that the tube well in Sector I-10/3 had not so far been connected with the main supply line. The Director (W&S) was, therefore, directed to ensure that this tube well was connected with the main supply line within 15 days. He was also asked to submit a compliance report in this behalf to Member(T) by August 16, 1975.

It was pointed out by F. A/Member that\_an offer for french credit of R. 2 crores for procurement of machinery for the Simly Dam had been made. The Director (W&S) was\_asked to examine whether it would be possible to utilise this offer for the procurement of machinery

required in the construction of Simly Dam and submit his report to the Board in this behalf.

## XII. General decisions.

- (i) It was decided by the Board that in future actual expenditure on the purchase of materials should be reflected in the progress\_reports. The Directors concerned were asked to bear in mind this directive while submitting material for the preparation of progress reports to the Director(T).
  - (ii) The Director(T) observed that in his opinion the tube wells already sunk would not produce sufficient water to cope with the requirement of water that would be needed during the next summer season. He, therefore, suggested that the possibility of sinking more tube wells should be explored. Taking cognizance of the proposal the Board asked Director (W&S) to look into the matter and if need be should take in hand sinking of more tube wells so that these are ready for operation by first of March, 1976.
