

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF THE
CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY HELD AT 9.00 A.M.
ON TUESDAY, THE 22ND NOVEMBER, 1966.

1. Provision of accommodation to CDA personnel serving in Islamabad or payment of an allowance in lieu thereof.

The summary submitted by the Director, Audit and Accounts was considered and it was decided that 60% of accommodation available for the CDA staff in Islamabad should be allotted to the staff of the Directorate General Works, and the remaining 40% allotted to such staff of other Directorates as works in Islamabad, on the basis of their seniority to be determined from the date of posting in Islamabad.

The Board did not approve the Director Audit & Accounts' proposal that individuals who work in Islamabad, and are not provided accommodation there, should be given compensatory allowance. It was, however, decided that in order to provide transport facility to such personnel, arrangements may be made for a bus which should leave Earkin Palace at 7.15 A.M. for Islamabad, and at 2.15 P.M. from Islamabad to the Earkin Palace.

2. CDA staff colony in Islamabad.

The F.A./Member pointed out that the former Chairman and the present Chairman had already agreed to the construction of a CDA staff colony in Islamabad, which should be progressed urgently to solve the housing problem of the CDA employees. After detailed discussion, it was decided that the Director, Planning should indicate the areas in sectors G-7 & G-8 for the construction of the colony urgently. Provision of houses for the staff of the Directorate General Works and the Directorate of Municipal Administration, who have to work in the Administrative sector and sectors G-6, F-6 & G-7 must be made in sector G-7.

The D.G.W. suggested that houses for the CDA employees may now be built on the plots/areas which have presently been reserved for the Central Secretariat in G-7; these houses can eventually be
