- The Boatd took the agenda itemwise for discussion and decision. Salient points of discussion and decisions s taken are given below:-
 - 6.1 Allotment of Agro farming plots against landed property.

The Board decided that the issue would be recast in the light of information from the Prime Minister's Secretariat.

6.3 Amendment in Section 116 of Municipal Ordinance 1960 relating to imposition of penalty on contravention of the provision of the Ordinance.

Board approved the proposal for amendment in Section 116 of the Municipal Administration Ordinance 1960 and desired that CDA Magistrate should invoke Martial Law Regulation No. 82 namely Pakistan Capital Regulation 1960 which is applicable to the Special Areas.

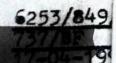

6.4 Restoration of NOC for Establishment of Institute of Islamic Science on land measuring 73 kanals and 17 marlas bearing Khasra No. 2343/2107 Mauzia Phulgran on Murree Road Zone IV Islamabad.

CDA Board decided that the case may be referred to the Cabinet Division as the construction carried out/proposed to be carried out was violative of ICT Zoning Regulation, 1992 as well as Islamabad Building Height Control Act 1995 and was thus not acceptable.

6.5 Allotment of alternate Land for Establishment of Khaldunia University of Arts and Sciences in Islamabad.

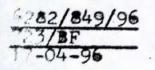
