The Chairman informed that he was not satisfied with the coordination functions of the Authority. He explained at length the requirement and needs of a correct coordination net-work. It was brought out by the Chairman that there were two type of works i.e. Routine and Creative. The higher echolon is expected to do more creative thinking, whereas the lower channel is required to dispose of routine functions. He also emphasised that most of the routine work should finish at DDG

level and policy matters be brought to the level of Members. The distribution of work may be indicated as:-
