6.1 <u>9973/1214/BM/'11</u> <u>30-06-'11/15TH</u> SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS AT ISLAMABAD HELIPORT OF 6 AVIATION SQUADRON CABINET DIVISION, ALLOTMENT OF 8 ACRES OF ADDITIONAL LAND (PM DIRECTIVE).



The Board examined the summary presented by Director General Planning and approved the allotment of 08 acres of land to Islamabad Heliport



of 6 Aviation Squadron, Cabinet Division for security arrangements. The land would be allotted / offered on the rate payable by Government Departments at the prevailing rate. CDA will not allow tall structures in the 62 acres area Buffer Zone adjacent to the landing strip, in order to facilitate the approach of incoming and outgoing Aircraft.

Director General (Planning) presented the summary to the CDA Board pertaining to the NOC for petrol pumps of Kashmir Highway / Motorway Link Road, Islamabad. The Board examined the issue and remarked that there is a ban on issuance of NOCs for CNG Pumps. However, the Board decided that pending NOCs for Petrol Pumps for which applications have already been received may be granted by the concerned Wing of CDA. The Board also directed that the policy for grant of such NOCs should be reviewed and comprehensive a presentation be given on the subject matter by the Planning Wing.

It was further decided that the whole sub-division policy should be revisited by the Finance Wing and the Directorates of Estate Management-I & II.

6.6 CONSTRUCTION OF CULTURAL COMPLEX

The matter pertaining to the construction of Cultural Complex project at Shakarparian was presented before the Board by Director (PMO) and it was decided that the scope of work of the project be limited in view of the present financial crunch. The Board approved the construction of a Cinema on modern lines but shelved the construction of the auditorium and amphitheatre on the following grounds:-

- i) The construction of Auditorium and Amphitheatre has become redundant and is not feasible given the close proximity of the Pak China Cultural Complex.
- ii) There are many conference centers and auditorium facilities in the city, which are ample to meet the present and future needs.

Hence the Board decided to review the scope of work of the remaining project and directed that the scope of work be substantially reduced. Director (MPO) and Member (Estate) were nominated to negotiate with the contractor in this regard in the best interest of the Authority. The Chair directed that Director (PMO) should be more proactive in such matters in future.
