

PUBLIC NOTICE

REMOVAL OF ENCROACHMENTS FROM CDA LAND / PUBLIC SPACES WITHIN ICT

The Capital Development Authority (CDA) is committed to preserving the planned character and beauty of Islamabad. It has been observed that encroachments on CDA land and public spaces including unassigned lands have been adversely impacting the city's environment, traffic, and public safety. The public-at-large, residents and business owners etc. within Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) are hereby informed that:

All forms of unapproved encroachments (temporary or permanent) must be removed voluntarily within ten (10) days from the date of publication of this notice.

This includes unauthorized structures/constructions, illegal extensions, kiosks, sheds, sports / recreational facilities and occupation of CDA land, right-of-way, greenbelts, and / or footpaths etc.

Non-compliance will invite strict legal and enforcement action, including removal of structures, imposition of fines, recovery of demolition costs, and proceedings under CDA Ordinance, 1960, and relevant byelaws etc. and CDA shall not be responsible for any loss or damages incurred during or after such removal.

Citizens and businesses are urged to cooperate voluntarily to help maintain a clean, safe, and orderly Islamabad.
