1. WATER SUPPLY

The Director (W&S) assured that the following works necessary to supplement the present water supply arrangements in Islamshad would be completed on the dates indicated against each work to

- a) Water supply from nullah in the golf course area. 31-3-1966.
- b) Scheme based on the Korang river after obtaining necessary clearance 30-4-1966. from WAPDA.
- Gompletien of Simly Conduction
 mains.
 31-5-1966.

(Conduction mains from Kurang river to Islamabad distribution system will, however, be completed by 31-3-1966)

d) Completion of filter beds at Simly for interim supply of water to Islamabed. 31-5-1966.

About the Kerang river scheme the Director (WAS) explained certain difficulties with regard to the land required for laying of the pipes. In order to solve this difficulty the Additional Director Lands was asked to complete the acquisition proceeding, if not already done and to arrange the payment of compensation to the affected people immediately.
