Item No. I

Subj: Shifting of the Ministries/Divisions, in October, 1966 from Rawalpindi/Karachi to Permanent Sectt. Buildings in Islamabad.

Rehabilitation & Works Division's Office memorandum dated 30th May, 1966, regarding the shifting of the Ministries/Divisions in October, 1966 from Rawalpindi/Karachi to the permanent Secretariat Blocks in Islamabad was considered, and following decisions were taken:-

- i. The office furniture that would be left behind by the Ministries/Divisions shifting from the office blocks in sector G-6 into the permanent Secretariat Blocks can be utilised by the Home Affairs Division which will be moving to these blocks in Islamabad from Pakistan Secretariat No. II, Rawalpindi. Similarly the office furniture to be left by the Ministries/Divisions shifting from Pak. Sectt. No. I, Rawalpindi into the permanent Sectt. Blocks in Islamabad can be used by the Ministry of Finance which will be shifting there from Pak. Sectt. No. II. The Reh. & Works Division may be advised accordingly.
- ii. Regarding the standardised items of office furniture to be supplied in the permanent Sectt. Blocks, the D.G.W. was requested to check if orders have been placed for the required quantities of each item, as indicated in the annexure to the O.M. under consideration.
- iii. In order to ensure completion of the Sectt. Buildings & houses and arrangements for facilities & services, it

was decided that the Member (A) should conduct meetings with the D.G.W. and other agencies who are responsible for provision of essential services in Islamabad. These meetings should be held as soon as possible, to ascertain present position. Thereafter fortnightly review meetings regarding progress in each item should be conducted.

- iv. The second carriage way of the National Avenue and north service road of F5/2 should also be completed before the next shift.

Item No. II

1067/172/66. Sub:- Management of water.

The summary submitted by the D.G.W. was considered and the following decisions were taken:-

- i. Water rent should be charged at a flat rate of Rs. 1.00 per month. The water rent should not be charged from the Class IV Government servants.
- ii. For domestic consumption, charges from Govt. employee should be levied at the rate of 60 paises per thousand gallons. It should be indicated that this rate is provisional and is subject to revision. In the case of Class IV Government servants, first 4,500 gallons per month should be supplied free of charge and any quantity consumed over 4,500 gallons should be charged at the rate of 60 paises per thousand gallons. Private consumers should be charged at the rate of Rs. 1.00 per 20 gallons.
- iii. Charges for water used for construction purposes should be levied at the rate of Rs. 1.00 per thousand gallons.
- iv. Water connection charges should be as follows :-
 - a) For 1/2" connection. = Rs. 90.00
 - b) for 3/4" " = Rs. 120.00
 - c) for 1" " = Rs. 230.00
 - d) for 1 1/2" " = Rs. 300.00

v. Procedure for meter reading, billing and collection should be finalised by the S.C.V. in consultation with the Director of Accounts.

vi. It was approved in principle that the bill section should be under the Dte. General Works and any staff sanctioned for similar work in the Dte. of Municipal Administration should be transferred to the Dte. General Works.

Item No. III.

No. 1068/172/66. Subj. Recruitment of deficient staff under the
Dte. General Works.

The summary submitted by the S.C.V. was considered and it was decided that appointment of the Accounts and drawing staff should be given priority. For other posts advertisement should be issued and candidates may be selected. Appointment should be made after the Standing Establishment Committee has approved the staff for the year 1966-67.

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
