1381/428/711. Revised Design of Enquiry
Office in Class V Centre.

2382/428/71 2. Minimum water rates for metered supply for domestic use like Sui Gas.

Summary on the captioned item was presented by Director Municipal Administration. The Board felt that it would be retrogressive step now to revert back to the flat rates. The original idea of installing the meters was not to penalise those persons who conserve water. The purpose was two folds, i.e. 1-

- a) to conserve water which was very searce in Islamabad, and
- b) to ensure an equitable billing so that neither CDA is put to loss nor consumers pay more than the service availed of:

If in few cases the consumers were billed much less than that of flat rates, we should accept the fact as it is, and bill them according to the services rendered to them by us. Therefore, fixing the minimum ceiling of rates for water consumption like Sui gas does not arise.
