## 6. RIVISED ESTIMATES FOR A.D.P. - 1969-70.

The Deputy Financial Adviser submitted the revised estimates for the A.D.P. - 1969-70, which was prepared in consultation with the Director General Works. The revised requirements were approved by the Board with the following observations :-

i. For the mosques, & 8 lacs may be provided instead of R. 5 lacs.

ii. R. 50 lacs should further be provided for acquisition of land. The amount of & .50 lacs should be released at the rate of &.10 lacs per month.

- iii. The position should again be reviewed by the D.G.W. and the Deputy Financial Adviser in March, 1970, and reported to the Board.
- iv. A copy of the revised ADP may be sent to the Cabinet Division.
