in Islamabad. It was felt that a large number of drains are blocked or choked. Besides no proper drainage scheme for the town as a whole was ever drawn. The Board, there fore, decided that immediate action should be taken by the Director General Works to clear the drains and draw a scheme for future improvement of the drainage system.

- far from being satisfactory. Many of the roads are washed away in every rain or are sub-merged in water. This partly happens because proper drains are not constructed to divert water to the nallah. This is why slush coming down from 5 MGD blocks the Margalla Avenue. Another reason appears to be the faulty specifications of roads because of which the roads are occassionally damaged or washed away. The Board, therefore, desired the Director General Works to have a thorough probe into the causes of damage to the roads and suggest measures to improve the drainage and stop further deterioration in the road condition.
 - 4. It came to the notice of the Board that some cracks have developed in one pillar of the Loi Bher Bridge. The Director General Works explained that this has occured because of the side erosion of the bridge which has been going on for many years. However, he explained that there was nothing very serious and the cracks are under constant study. He had also written a letter to the designers to give their opinion about the cracks and the reasons for its development. The Board desired that Member (T) should look into the whole matter and inform the Board of all details and suggest measures to rectify.
