- iii) Water meters may be installed immediately in all the private and government houses including those occupied by the Class IV servants. In the case of Class IV servants a limit for free supply of water should be fixed with the approval of the Govt. beyond which the occupants should be charged according to the rates fixed.
- iv) Water for construction purposes should not be supplied free, but should be charged for according to the rates fixed by the FA/Member. The Law Officer was requested to examine the proposal for recovery of charges for the water already used by the owners of private houses, and put up his views for consideration of the Board.
