The question of the principles on which this area was being question of the principles on which that the Authority Be loved planned was also discussed. It was felt that the Authority did not find an integrated approach in the Urban Planning Cases being put up to it. There was no conception of the city as a whole, and of what was required for its balanced growth. Deputy Director Urban Planning admitted that the 29(118) Urban Planning side needed to be greatly strengthened. In fact, the CDA still had on by the Doxiadis' master plan to go by and piece meal changes were being made in it as and when some part of the plan was felt to be outdated, poorly Conce ived or inadequate to changed conditions. What was required was complete re-thinking of the principles on which the city of Islamabad was to develop and the creation of a new master plan. Deputy Director Urban Planning was asked to put up a proposal for strengthening the Urban Planning Section to cope with the situation."
