## ALLOTETAT OF PLOTS OF TRUCK STAND IN SECTOR I-11, ISLAMABAD.

3<u>325/628/79</u> · The summary submitted by Director Planning considered by the Board. The salient feature's of the summary were explained by Director Planning. ' question whether the plots be allotted to the Goods Forwarding Companies on the terms and conditions P/2..

listed in para-7 of the summary or be disposed of through open auction was discussed at length. The Cammissioner, Rawalpindi felt that the cost of land @ %.65/- per sq: yrd proposed to be charged from the allottees was on the high side and may not be acceptable by the Goods Forwarding Companies. He added that since the intention was to move the trucks out of Rawalpindi city to ease traffic congestion there, some incentive will have to be provided to the persons who were going to be affected with the proposed shifting as other-wise they were likely to resist the proposal. It was pointed out by D.F.A. in this regard that according to the current Government approved policy the plot for this scheme, which is of commercial nature, will have to be leased out through open auction. This view was endorsed by many others.

After some discussion it was agreed that the plan already prepared be reviewed and modified with a view to reducing the cost and the plan so revised be made available to the Costing Cell for working out the revised cost. It was decided that the entire exercise should be completed within 10 days and a revised summary be prepared for consideration by the Board.

It was also decided that advance payment made by the two companies may be refunded immediately.
