6.	The salient features of Budget Estimates 2008-09 are as under:-
9.8	
i	Budget 2008-09 is a surplus budget (Rs.51.136 m) with a financial out lay of Rs.25,889.634 million.
ii	75% of total budget will be spent on development projects.
iii	No new tax is proposed to be levied.
iv	Increase in pay and pension as announced by the Federal Government for employees / pensioners has been catered for.
V	Budget 2008-09 is 4% more than the budget estimates 2007-08.
vi	The focus of the budget is on development with allocation of Rs.19,376.441 million despite of the fact that Federal Government has reduced PSDP allocation to CDA from Rs.1.050.297 million (2007-08) to Rs.392.114 million (2008-09).
vii	Total funding by the Federal Government for the year 2008-09 is Rs.1,558.114 m which is 6% of total budget (Maintenance Grant Rs.1166.00 M + PSDP Rs.392.114 M).
viii	In the development budget roads, special projects, environment, water supply and sewerage sectors have been allocated maximum funds.
ix	In order to control the non-development expenditure new posts would only be created which can substantially contribute to improve the revenue generation and efficiency of the organization. Efforts would also be made to meet the staff requirement by internal adjustment/ restructuring. Other non-development expenditure will be frozen as per instruction of the federal government.
X	Non-development expenditure is Rs.6,513.193 million.

He explained stated that funds will be utilized only after approval of PC-I / Revised PC-I. Concerned Director will be responsible for enforcing financial discipline. Performance regarding Revenue Generation will be monitored on quarterly basis. New sources of funds generation will be identified by the concerned Directors. It is proposed that separate committees may be constituted for monitoring of works relating to Street Lights, Soft-landscaping, Sewerage, Grounds and Parks. The proposed committees will be constituted by concerned Member in consultation with FA/Member.

He further explained that the Annual Works Programme (AWP) for 2008-09 amounting to Rs.25,889.634 million including development expenditure of Rs.19,376.141 million and non-development expenditure amounting to Rs.6,513.193 million against the estimated receipt of Rs.25,940.770 million with a surplus of Rs.51.136 million is submitted for consideration and approval of the CDA Board.

DECISION

The Board approved the CDA Budget for the year 2008-09 proposed by the Deputy Financial Adviser-I.

Action: Dy. Financial Adviser-l
