2. Hiring of Low Cost Houses for the CDA Employees

The summary was presented by the Admin Officer Br coord who explained the background of the case. It was observed by the Chairman that according to normal rules, a 1. A. L. Cood Government servant who may be owning his own accommodation 2. Askn officer remain in government accommodation for a period of 5 years. After some discussion the following decisions were taken:-

> 1) The actual position with regard to admissibility of the government accommodation to a Government servantowning his own house should be ascertained from the Government and followed in letter and spirit.

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2) CDA employees who have not been allotted any government accommodation and have requested for de-hiring of their low-cost houses obtained by the CDA should have the prior right to live in their own houses. Such houses should, therefore, be released and their present occupants be allotted first available accommodation.

4. Construction of Infectious Diseases Hospital

The summary was presented by the Director M&HS.

1-Bmiles After some discussion the proposal was approved in principle and it was decided that the DM&HS should submit a proper plan in this behalf and take necessary steps for getting it approved. The proposed site should not be in the vicinity of the College.

5. Introduction of sports in the CDA

The summary was presented by the Director Finance

Start Goal, who requested for the approval of the recommendations of
the Sub-Committee. The Director Maintenance argued that
many man-hours are already wasted by the staff members
on the plea of going to dispensaries and various activities
of the unions and that in case the sports activities as
recommended are also encouraged it would provide an other
occasion to absent themselves from the duty. After
lengthy discussion the recommendations were eventually
accepted with the following provisions:-

- Sports activities should not be to the deteriment of office work and the interest of the Authority.
- 2) All sports practices/activities must be confined to after office hours except in case of tournaments.
- 3) If unavoidably some players are to attend any functions etc., within office hours, they must seek prior permission from the Director concerned before leaving their offices.
- 4) In the composition of the Sports Committee only Captains of the Teams should be included and not the Secretaries.

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Construction of Pedestrian Streets, Foot-Paths etc. for the Low Cost Houses in G-7/2 & G-7/3/

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The summary on the subject was presented by the Director Finance, who indicated that delay in the work was not because of the late sanction of the pestimates as the work had already been carried out prior to the submission of the estimates. It was generally observed by the Chairman that Finance Wing should clear the estimates speedily and that no undue delay should occur. The Director General Works was also advised to follow the laid down procedure in future.

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Ejectment of residents of Revenue Estate Lunda Mastal

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The case was presented and explained by the Additional Director Lands. It was decided that a proper summary should be submitted by the Additional Director Lands in the next meeting.

AD-HOC ITEM

1) Development of Sectors Mehran 7 (E-7) and Shalimar 10(F-10)

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It was desired by the Chairman that elopment of these sectors must be completed in all respects by September and December, 1974 respectively so that by that time possession of the plots could be handed over to the allottees. He cited the example of G-8 & G-9 where plots were allotted in 1971-72 but the possession could not be given for a number of years for want of proper development. This was not a happy position in any respect and must not be repeated. It was emphasised by the Chairman that mere advertisement for the sale of plots would not be the end of CDA's responsibility but it should be treated as a start and greater zeal should be shown in the development of these plats in the desired manner and on top priority basis. It was accordingly decided that all concerned agencies must gear up their efforts and ensure full development of the sectors by the given time.
