Item No. I

1072 /173/66. Subj: Allotment of land in sector I-9 - Manufacturing Industry Area.

The summary submitted by the I.P.O. was considered by the Board and allotment of plots No. 116-137 to the Oil and Gas Development Corporation was approved. Regarding the proposal of M/s. Mohammad Shafi and Mohammad Amin & Co., it was considered that the type and size of the plant was such that it should not be installed in the manufacturing industry area. They should, therefore, be considered for allotment of land in the I & T centre.

It was desired that the Director Planning should prepare a plan for the mauve area of sector G-7, where provision for such services should be made towards the residential area. After the plan, to be prepared by the Director Planning, is approved by the Board the I.P.O. should prepare a scheme for allotment of plots in that area.

Item No. II

1073/173/66. Subj: Cross-section of the National Avenue.

The cross-section of the National Avenue was considered by the Board and it was decided that the 60' strip provided towards the western plot line (i.e. Pakistan House side) should be distributed as follows :-

1. Pedestrian walk way = 10 ft. from the plot line.
2. Green strip. = 5 ft. from the Pedestrian walk way.

- 3. Cycle track. = 10 ft. from the Green strip
- 4. Green. = 35 ft. from the Cycle track

It was further decided that the green strip on the outside (i.e. towards the Diplomatic Enclave) should also be 35 ft. from the Cycle track. The Director Planning was requested to prepare the complete cross-section of the National Avenue accordingly, which may be shown to the Board before supplying it to the Directorate of Works.
