I. SECURITY OF SECRETARIAT BUILDINGS.

The Comptroller of Secretariat Buildings explained the incident that took place on 17.2.69 as a result of the students procession. After some discussion it was decided that the matter may be referred to the Government, and as a first measure barbed wire fencing should be provided around the Secretariat Buildings as suggested by the Local Administration. The Government should also be requested to approach the provincial Government for providing a police post for the protection and security of Secretariat Buildings.

II. DOMESTIC SERVANTS SURVEY IN ISLAMABAD.

The Director Planning explained the salient features of the Survey Report. It was observed that the random sample design had been disturbed considerably because of the fact that the response was received only from 140 units out of 400 randomly selected units. It was, therefore, not advisable to adopt the results of the survey as basis for planning in Islamabad. The necessity of providing housing accommodation for domestic servants was however felt by the Board, and it was decided that about 50% accommodation for the assessed requirements in respect of Sector G-6 should be arranged. It was desired that the Director Architecture and Director Planning should select suitable site/sites in Sector G-6 or G-7. The Director Architecture was requested to prepare a design which should be simple so that the rent of each unit worked out on the basis of recovery of cost spread over a period of 25 years should be between Rs. 15 & 20 per month.

III. DESIGN OF CLASS III CENTRE MOSQUE IN SECTOR G-6/4, ISLAMABAD.

The Deputy Director Architecture presented the design of the mosque, which was approved. It was desired that provision of adequate light and heating arrangements should be made.

IV. FOLDABLE SUN SHADES OVER THE ENTRANCE OF SECRETARIAT BLOCKS, ISLAMABAD.

After some discussion it was decided that possibilities of some portable sun-shades may be looked into by the Director Architecture, who should suggest a design for consideration of the Board. It was also decided that the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Welfare may be informed that the folding sun-shades were not locally available.

V. PROVISION OF TRAFFIC LIGHTS IN ISLAMABAD.
