MINUTES OF THE 16TH CDA BOARD MEETING OF 1992 HELD ON 16TH NOVEMBER, 1992 AT 1400 HOURS

 - 7.1. Issuance of licences to Ex-CDA Employees to practice as an Architect without obtaining registration/enlistment with PCATP.

Board did not accede to the request of issuing licence to practice as an unregistered Architect in the light of the rules of PCATP in this regard.

- 7.4. Permission for additional permissible covered area/additional storey to Motel sites in the Hational Park Area.

It was decided that covered area upto 70% with two storeys would be permitted free of charge for the construction of Motels in the National Park area. The maximum buildable area on the ground floor shall be 50% of the plot size. The charges for the covered area beyond 70% would be @ Rs. 67/- per sq.ft. upto the maximum limit of 80%.

7.5. Levy of Toll Tax by CDA on Islamabad Highway and Kashmir Highway

- A. The Board approved the proposal to levy Toll Tax in principle at rates proposed in para 7 of the summary and directed that procedure as prescribed in the Capital Development Authority (Imposition of Taxes) Rules, 1981 may be followed; subject to the following:
- (a) The Toll Tax Barriers/Booths should be located at the following four points:
 - Soan Bridge: On the Southern side of the Islamabad Highway.
 - (2) On the Kashmir Highway: Near Golra Mor across the Railway Bridge towards Islamabad.
 - (3) I.J. Principal Road: Near the Railway Crossing.

- (4) Murree Road: At the point where it enters Islamabad.
- (b) Items relating to exemptions were approved (para 8 of the summary) except items i, ix and x which were deleted. Item (iii) was decided to be amended to read as under:

"Car, bearing Diplomatic and Foreign Mission Number plates".

- (c) Rate for the annual pass which was proposed to be issued by CDA, was fixed at Rs. 30/- per annum.
- B. Commissioner Rawalpindi may be requested to remove the existing octroi post on the Kashmir Highway.

Charges for conversion of use from flats to offices in the Buildings on Jinnah Road

7.9. Building Bye-laws for Cinema buildings in residential sectors of Islamabad - Revised standards

The proposal was approved by the Board and an additional coverage of 20 per cent of the total plot area was allowed for commercial use. The permission for additional coverage would necessitate changes in other provisions e.g. total coverage, side set backs, location of commercial activity etc. and are to be incorporated in the existing standards.
