Subject:- MINUTES OF THE 14TH SPECIAL MEETING OF CDA BOARD FOR THE YEAR 2006 REGARDING BUDGET ESTIMATES 2006-2007.

The 14th special meeting of CDA Board for the year 2006 regarding Budget Estimates 2006-2007 was held on Tuesday the 20th June, 2006 at 11.00 a.m. in the Conference Room, Executive Block, CDA Headquarters, Islamabad.

- 4. Commissioner, ICT, Islamabad and DCO, Rawalpindi could not attend the meeting due to some other official assignments.
- 5. Meeting commenced with the recitation from the Holy Quran by Brig. Nusrat Ullah Member (P & D).
  - I) Member Finance presented the Budget Estimates for financial year 2006-2007 through slides of multi-media and elaborated its salient features as under:-

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#### SALIENT FEATURES

- i) BUDGET 2006-07 IS A SURPLUS BUDGET WITH A FINANCIAL OUT LAY OF RS.21,238.026 MILLION.
- ii) 80% OF TOTAL BUDGET WILL BE SPENT ON DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS i/c COST OF LAND AND 20% ON NON-DEVELOPM-MENT EXPENDITURES.
- iii) NO NEW TAX IS PROPOSED TO BE LEVIED.
- iv) INCREASE IN PAY AND PENSION AS ANNOUNCED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR ALL REGULAR EMPLOYEES / PENSIONERS HAS BEEN CATERED FOR.
- v) BUDGET 2006-07 IS RS.3,988.713 MILLION OR 23% MORE THAN THE BUDGET ESTIMATES 2005-06.
- vi) THE FOCUS OF THE BUDGET IS ON DEVELOPMENT WITH RECORD ALLOCATION OF RS.16887.574 MILLION i.e 24% MORE THAN THE DEVELOPMENT BUDGET ESTIMATES (2005-06 Rs.13,660.380M).
- vii) TOTAL FUNDING BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR 2006-07 IS RS.2524.914 M INCLUDING RS.174.472 M FOREIGN LOAN WHICH IS 12% OF TOTAL BUDGET.
- viii) IN THE DEVELOPMENT BUDGET MAJOR EMPHASIS IS ON DEVELOPMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE.

- IN ORDER TO CONTROL THE NON-DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE NEW POSTS WOULD ONLY BE CREATED WHICH CAN SUBSTANTIALLY CONTRIBUTE TO IMPROVE THE REVENUE GENERATION AND EFFICIENCY OF THE ORGANIZATION. EXISTING VACANT VACANCIES WOULD BE FILLED DURING THE YEAR 2006-07. EFFORTS WOULD ALSO BE MADE TO MEET THE STAFF REQUIREMENT BY INTERNAL ADJUSTMENT/ RESTRUCTURING.
- x) IT IS PROPOSED TO COMPLETE ACTION REGARDING PREPARATION AND APPROVAL OF PC-Is OF UNAPPROVED SECTORS / SCHEMES.
