Item No. I

Sub: RE-ALIGNMENT OF CAPITAL AVENUE.

Mr. Antahopolous, Rep. of Doxiadis Associates presented before the Board the thinking of Dr. C.A. Doxiadis regarding the re-alignment of the Capital Avenue. The Board considered the solution suggested by Dr. Doxiadis and desired that a preliminary study and plan, indicating the width of the proposed ceremonial approach road running through the Blue Area in F-6 and the dimensions on either side of the ceremonial road may be submitted before the Board at the earliest. Mr. Antahopolous was, therefore, requested to indicate the cost/ fees etc., including the foreign exchange elements for this work to be done at Rawalpindi or alternatively at Athens.
