- The Board considered the summaries included in the Agenda circulated vide Coordination Section's Memo. No. CDA-577/BM-Coord/75, dated 12th July, 1975 and took the following decisions.
- Provision of facilities in Poultry i) and Vegetable Scheme No. III, Kahuta Road, Islamabad.

The Board did not agree to the proposal On Hoth the metalling of roads in the area of the scheme should be done by the CDA at its own expense. The approved scheme does not contain a provision for it and it will state fee not be a good principle of policy to accept a liability which is outside the scope of the agreement. It was, therefore, decided that the Director Hort: should, in the first instance, approach the allottees and find out from them whether they were willing to pay the additional cost in volved in metalling of the roads.

The proposals that a suitable plot should be earmarked by the Planning Directorate for the establishment of a Civic Centre and that Coordination Officer should approach the concerned departments for establishment of post-office and opening of public school in the area of the scheme, were approved.

Revision of procedure for licencing and regulations of architects/ consulting engineers in CDA.

After considering the summary, it was decided that the proposal would be considered at a meeting of the Special Board. In the meantime, Director Planning, 4- O. Korks DMA. Director Works-I and Director M&HS should point out 🍒 🔑 m 🕊 s at-least 5 residential buildings each which have been designed by qualified Architects but in their opinion are not aosthetically good.

Allotment of plots to NCC for construction of houses for Pakistanis living abroad.

The Chairman pointed out that summary has been placed before the Board completely ingoring the contents of Town Planning & Agrovilles Division's letter of March, 1975, according to which the proposal is to be discussed initially with the Chairman, Pakistan Management Corporation Ltd. and Managing Director, National Construction. Company Ltd. In view of the said letter, a working paper should have been prepared for meeting with Pakistan Management Corporation and National Construction Co. instead of putting up a summary containing definite recommendations on this issue to the Board. It was decided that Planning Director's summary should be returned and Secretary, CDA, would coordinate the preparation of a working paper for for the said meeting.
