ii) Fixation of Sui Gas Charges for un-metered supply to occupants of Government quarters in Islamabad.

The salient features of the summary were explained to the Board by the Director Municipal Administration.

It was felt that due to un-metered supply of gas, there was no compulsion for the consumer to restrict consumption to his genuine requirement. It was, therefore, decided that the sui gas charges for un-metered supply of gas should be brought at par with those fixed by the Sui Gas company for un-metered supply of gas and the pressure of gas should also be reduced in consultation with Sui Gas Campany. Regarding the rates, it was decided that it shall be decided by Director Municipal Administration in consultation with F. A/Member. The Director Municipal Administration was asked to prepare a brief for the Minister indicating the reasons for enhancement of Sui Gas Charges and submit it to Chairman. It was further decided that the Sui Gas Company should once again be pressed for the installation of individual meters and if need be, the matter should be taken up with the Government.
