The Director Horticulture pointed out that the cattle of the milkmen in Islamabad generally destroy the trees planted by his Directorate. He, therefore, suggested that the area for dairy farms should now be earmarked in the National Park area. The need for properly planned dairy farming in Islamabad was felt and the question was discussed in detail. The following decisions were taken :-

- i. The Director Horticulture will immediately indicate on the plan the sites proposed by him in the National Park Area for dairies.
- ii. The Director Planning should inspect the sites and prepare a layout plan on 30 acre plot module. The layout plan should be put up to the Board in the next meeting.
- iii. Brig. Zafar be requested to attend the next Board meeting for discussion and advise on the subject.

The Review Report for the month of December, 1965, was considered in detail and it was observed that progress of work was generally unsatisfactory & behind schedule. So far as the water supply position is concerned, it was desired that the Director of Water Supply along with his two Deputy Directors should be called at 8.30 A.M. on 26-1-1966 to explain to the Board the present position about the supply of water from Simly and other sources.
