Following decisions were taken :- :

2)09/4/6/711. D sposal of residential plots in Islamabad.

The Board felt that one of the fundamentals of sound Town Planning is that the land must return to the Metropoliten Authority after at least 90 or 100 years so that a city could be replanned according to the needs of the time. In all cities En! Cantonments of Pakistan and in all new cities abroad, the rent dential plots are allotted on the basis of 99 years lease, Selection in Islamabad the residential plo .. were being sold. This was reportedly done in the beginning vith a view to attract the pcople as a measure of incentive. It was considered desirable that the plots should be allotted on lease, so that the land could revert to the Authority after 91 years. After some consideration it was decided that as an inter m measure all residential plots in the new sectors and odel villages in Islamabad should hendeforth be allotted on 99 wears perpetual lease. In the mean time the matter may be referred to the Government if necessary. In view that the developm it cost etc. of the plots would be charged in the form of premiss, only meanal annual ground rent should be fixed.

2310/4/6/7/ 2. Development of Sectors Ramna 8 & Ramna 9.

In view that these Sectors have to be developed on self-financing basis, it was considered desirable, that the development and lease of residential plots should be so phased as to ensure full utilisation of the developed areas and smooth construction of houses by the allottees.

After detailed discussion it was decided by the Board that development of the area of private plots in sub-Sectors Ramna 8/1 & 2, falling between the two nullahs, running north-south through these sub-sectors, should be undertaken in the first instance. The development of part of sub-Sector Ramna 8/4, where construction of T&T housingwas already in progress, should also be undertaken simultaneously.

In order to determine the scope of further phases of development, it was decided that applications should be invited through an advertisement on a prescribed form wherein the applicants should specifically indicate the date when they would de in a presition to untertake the conse truction of their houses. In the application form, an undertaking should also be obtained from the applicants to the effect that if they failed to undertake and complete the construction of houses within the promised time, they would be liable to pay the penalty to be specified later. The Estate Officer was directed to device an application form urgently and expedite issue of the advertisement.

In order to ensure that facilities like gas, electricity, telephones and schools etc. are also timely provided by other agencies, the Director General Works was directed to take up the matter with respective agencies and ensure that nocessary action is taken by them to achieve the desired pumpose.

CDA Housing Colony.

It was noted that the GPA has not so far constructed any houses for its employees, which should have been rightly we done in the very beginning. Presently the Con is paying a consider; ble amount as rent for the private houses, and a Estal officer

large number of CDA employees were still without residential accommodation and experiencing great hardship on that account. The efforts of the Authority for construction of houses had in the past failed for want of funds for the purpose. The Board felt that it would be economical and also otherwise, desirable to undertake construction of at least 50% of the CDA's residential requirement by taking loan from the banks, or sale of debentures. It was, therefore, decided that a reference, giving complete details of the rent paid by the Authority for houses and the amount required for the construction of GDA Golony, should be made to the Government by the Finance Wing seeking approval to the proposal of construction of these houses by raising loan from the banks.;

The Chairman enquired as to when the development of the Blue Area could be started. The L.G.W. informed that the design of services had just been completed and estimates will now be prepared, which would be submitted within a period of one month.
