5. CONSTRUCTION OF 2ND CARRAGE WAY OF ISLANABAD.

It was stated that tenders for the portion of the road from Lehtrar to Airport Link Road had been invited and received but since anticipatory approval for the subject work was still awaited, processing of the tenders was held up. A.D.(Evaluation) explained that the matter was being pursued with the Planning Commission for arranging anticipatory approval of the Chairman, ECCCC but the same was still awaited. It was decided that a d.o. letter from Chairman, CDA to Secretary, Planning Division requesting for issue of anticipatory approval upto March, 1979 be put up by A.D.(Evaluation) immediately.

Chairman observed that in an earlier B_Oard meeting it was decided that the portion of this road should be completed by April, 1979. He said that had the issue of anticipatory approval been brought to his notice earlier, it could have been sorted out much earlier. He, However, added that in order to make up the delay, concerted efforts should now be made to complete the work by the date fixed earlier i.e. end of April, 1979 as he hoped that anticipatory approval would be arranged in a couple of days.
