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The meeting started with the recitation from the Holy Quran. The Board considered the Summary on the Agenda. Brief account of the discussion and the decisions taken is as follows:-

Acquisition of lands/build up property and payment of compensation thereof.

a. The Director Re-habilitation and Lands

During discussion on item(a) regarding payment of compensation on the basis of General Price Indices, it was explained that Commissioner CDA's award under reference had been submitted on file to the Board and payment was made after approval. On enquiry from the Chairman Manapplication of Indices formula for calculation of compensation was explained by the Director Rehabilitation & Lands. The Chairman however, desired that the details as to how these calculations are done should be shown to him in Office by the Director Reh & Lands.

It was felt that payment on the basis
of General Price Indices was not in
accordance with the provisions in the CDA
Ordinance. If, however, payment, had/been
made due to court decision, action for
amendment in the CDA Ordinance should have
been taken immediately. It is, therefore,
necessary that the law should be amended
to validate these payments and the
amendment should have retrospective affect
to cover the payments already made. It was
explained by the Law Officer that action for
amendment of Section 2(k) had been initiated

case a large number of amendments have have proposed. The case ultimately was considered by the Cabinet in its meeting on 4.6.1990, when all amendments were approved except section 2(k) relating to market value! In this regard the Cabinet directed that Land Acquisition Act 1894 should be extended to the Islamabad Capital Territory. CDA has explained to the Cabinet Division that the decision will create difficulties, and has requested for its re-consideration.

The Cabinet Division in response has asked for a Summary.

aspects of the case, it was decided that the Summary asked for by the Cabinet Division should be immediately prepared by the Director Reh. & Lands, in consultation with the Law Officer (Litigation) and the CDA Counsel, highlighting the issues involved and sent to the Cabinet Division for re-consideration.

of the Cabinet decision. The Summary should include a separate, but short, paragraph requesting that the payments already made since 1982 on the basis of Indices formula should be regularized with a view to avoid/settle

audit objections. A request for issue of the amendment in the shape of Ordinance should also be made in the Summary.

The Director Reh. & Lands was directed to submit the Summary by Wednesday the 29th August, 1990.

During discussion, it was pointed out that b. Since Deputy Commissioner's action allowing compensation for the period between the announcement of the award and the date of appeal, amounted to undue over payment and was not in order, the CDA should have gone in appeal against those decisions. The Chairman desired that a comprehensive position should be explained to him as to why the award was not challenged in the Court and also indicating the names of the Officers (D.Cs. CDA) who awarded compensation, indicating the amount so paid. In this regard the Director Reh. & Lands was directed to submit comprehensive position to the Chairman by 15th September, 1990 positively.

c. Regarding the change of classification of land the CDA Counsel explained the background of the case with particular reference to the cases affected by the Rawal Dam canals.

It was stated that the CDA had gone in writ against certain decisions, and the matter was also referred to the Law Ministry. The change in the classification of land had been accepted in accordance with the advice given by the Law Ministry.

After some discussion it was decided that for future acquisition the Islamabad Revenue Office should be requested to keep the Registered Haqdaran Zamin upto-date, so that the classification of lands at the time acquisition is available.

The minutes of the meeting as recorded above 3. may kindly be seen for favour of confirmation before these are circulated to all concerned for taking further action called for on their part.
