Item No. I.

Case No.1009/160/66.

Sub: STEPS TO BE TAKEN TO CHECK UNAUTHORISED
BUILDING ACTIVITY.

The Board considered the summary submitted by the Director of Planning and decided that in order to control the unauthorized building activity around the junction of the G.T.Road and Kohat Road sufficient area should be acquired. The Director of Planning was requested to carry out a survey of the site and suggest the area, including the presently active area, to be acquired.

It was also decided that the P.W.D. and the Railway authorities should be requested not to lease out any land on either side of the roads/railway tracks within the Capital boundary.

Item No. II.

Case No.1010/160/66.

Sub: SELECTION OF SITE FOR THE RAILWAY
CARRIAGE FACTORY, ISLAMABAD.

The summary prepared by the Deputy Director (Regional Planning) was considered by the Board and it was decided that the proposal of the Railways authorities contained in para 3(c) of the summary may be accepted.

During the discussion the Additional Director of Lands pointed out an instance where the award was enhanced from Rs. 150/00 to Rs.1200/00 per Kanal by one of the previous Commissioners. The Additional Director Lands was asked to examine all such cases and.....P..2.
