The Special Board meeting of CDA Board was held on Friday, the 17th September, 2010 at 3.00 p.m in the office of Chairman, CDA, Islamabad.

- Meeting commenced with the recitation from the Holy
 Quran by Mr. Nadeem Akbar Malik, Secretary CDA Board.
- 4. CDA Board discussed the implementation status of Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan Judgment dated 04-06-2010 and thereafter observations of the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan which were given by the Supreme Court of Pakistan today i.e. on 17-09-2010 that decision has not been implemented in letter and spirit. Chairman, CDA as well as Secretary Establishment were summoned in person. During the proceedings the Honourable Bench observed that the Judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan has not been implemented and that no civil and criminal proceedings have so far been filed against the delinquent officers / officials. The Bench further observed that this was a clear case where the NAB Authorities would have conducted investigation. The Honourable Bench of the Supreme Court of Pakistan adjourned the case for 20-09-2010 for further proceedings in order to decide the criminal originals 36 and 72 of 2010 after conducting the further hearing on the said date.
- 5. In view of the observations of the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan during today's hearing as well as the directions issued by the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan in sub-para-5 of para-36 of the Judgment. The CDA Board decided that a written request to be made to the Chairman, NAB to conduct inquiry / investigation against the delinquent officials of the CDA as well as the others who were involved in this case.
- 6. The meeting concluded with a word of thanks to and from the Chair.
