Following decisions were taken by the Board.

1. Approval of landscape designs:

a) Right of way of 6th Avenue.

The summary on the captioned item was moved by Mr. Abdul Qadir, Landscape Archt. He explained the salient features of the landscaping design of 6th Avenue. The Board approved the proposal subject to the following observations :-

- i) The median strip of the double carriage way not to be developed.
- ii) Shrubs not to be planted close to road pavement as they are likely to be spoiled or damaged/destroyed at the time of the construction of road.
- iii) In order to eliminate the look as of a corridor, number of trees should be reduced.
- iv) The landscape work should be undertaken keeping in view the level of the Road.

that for the time being only one retaining wall should be constructed near Government Hostel where the water should be stored and converted into a small lake.

iii. Nullah Park in Diplomatic Enclave behind US Embassy

Summary on the captioned item was presented by Sh: Abdul Qadir, Landscape Arch. The Board approved the proposal in principle. The Board, however, felt that for the time being, no expenditure should be incurred, excepting the plantation should be done. The Board felt that the landscaping work in Diplomatic Enclave can be postponed as more attention should be paid to the settled sectors of Islamabad.

Master Plan of Dairy Farm and Dairy Factory

Project Director, Dairy Factory, Lt. Col. Rizwan of the A.D.C., presented the master plan of the dairy farm and dairy factory. The Board approved the master plan with the following observations :-

- a. Sewerage disposal in Kurang River should be after treatment.
 - b. Buildings for residential purposes should be kept to the minimum essentials.

 - d. The building line shall not be within 300' from the edge of the right-of-way.
 - e. The proposal shall be cleared by DGM&HS before it is finally approved by Director Architecture and Director Planning.
