Item No. I

Sub:- Quality of Water Supply in Islamabad.

The report regarding the quality of water supply in Islamabad received from the Ministry of Health was considered in detail. As all the chemical and bacteriological test reports available with the D.G.W. indicated that the water was fit for human consumption, it was decided that further discussions should take place between Dr. Rehman and the Director (WAS), CDA, who should submit a joint report to the Board, for consideration.

Item No. II.

Covered Bazar in C6/3-4.

For working out the cost of cinema in Sector C6-V, the question of land that should form its part was discussed. As the main parking area was not actually meant for the visitors to the picture-house but was to serve the needs of the entire area (including the shopping centres, the restaurant and other facilities) it was decided to exclude this portion of the land while assessing the price. The smaller parking area, within the boundary of the picture-house which can be used by the visitors to cinema only, should be considered as part of the cinema and the price worked out accordingly.

The question of land for the covered bases also come under discussion, and it was decided that the area relating to the building proper only, as indicated on the plan presented before the Board, should be considered to be part of the covered bases project. It was desired that the capital cost of this project should be revised by excluding the following costs:

- i. cost of land which has now been left out, and was included in the capital cost calculated earlier,
- ii. cost of development of the car perk in the excluded area,
- iii. cost of construction of public toilets
  in the emuladed area.

Subi- Allogment of plots in the Industrial Trading Centres

The summary submitted by the T.I.C. was considered and the Hember (A) was requested to call the following 3 parties and examine if their requirements can be adjusted within the 5 available plotss-

- 1. Craft Contempora.
- 11. Amin Corporation.
- 111. Punjab Harble Factory.

In case it is not possible to accommodate all of them, then the allotment should be made to the parties at (ii) & (iii).
