Allotment of Plot No. 38, Markaz G-9, Islamabad.

DEM-II explained the case. Plot No. 38, Markaz G-9 was allotted to M/s Talib Aziz and Others on 27-5-1995 through open auction held on 13-01-1992. The plot was withdrawn due to non payment on 7-8-1997. The exallottee requested for restoration of plot within 3 months.

The allotment of plot may be restored subject to payment of all outstanding dues including restoration/delayed payment charges as required under the prevailing policy.

8.2 Maintenance and operation of fountains.

Director Coord (Parliament House) explained the case. He said that 20 Nos fountains located at various sites of the City are being operated departmentally through daily wages staff which is not satisfactory arrangement. He suggested that the functioning of fountains may be privatized in order to achieve proper accountability. This will also reduce the expenditure of the Authority.
