The summary on the captioned item was presented Dir Cound & MA by the Director Municipal Administration. The Board felt that it is not necessary to have directional boards. hoardings etc. in Islamabad. What probably is essential for sometimes more, are the directional boards of the Gove nment offices and the Embassies. Therefore, the Board decided that all directional boards/ hoardings should be removed except in case of Embassies and Government offices for which properly designed boards should be installed. It should also be examined whether it would be worthwhile for CDA to put up certain boards giving the addresses of the major Government offices, institutions and embassies. Similarly, proper boards should be designed for CDA offices and then put up in front of concerned offices.

2372/425/7/ 2. Construction of library within Anjuman Faizul Islam School in Faizabad.

Si Planning

Director Planning explained the background of the building of Anjuman Faizul Islam's school. According to him, he paid a visit along with the Chairman recently. The school is partly located within the 600' right-of-way of Kyaban-i-Sir Syed and partly outside. Detailing the background of the school building, he explained that the Anjuman had applied for permission to construct the high school building. This permission was refused by the Board on the ground that the building is located on the main highway crossing which will create traffic hazards. It was also suggested that the school building should be constructed in 'H' series where they will be given land free of cost. In the meantime, the school authorities approached the Commissioner and the Municipal Committee and the Municipal Committee allowed the building to be constructed. As such, the building was constructed un-authorisedly. It was because of the sensitive nature of the project that the CDA did not take further steps to demolish the building. If the library building is allowed to be constructed which is within 600' right-of-way of Khayaban-i-Sir Syed and 220' right-of-way of Murree Road, we will be regularising one of the irregularities committed in the past.

The Board considered the various aspects of the case. It was felt that CDA has not yet fixed the major land use in this area. Unless a scheme for the major land use is prepared or caused to be prepared, it is very difficult to stop the mushroom growth which is going on in this area. It is, however, essential that keeping in view the future expansion of the highways no major building is raised otherwise it would be difficult to remove it at a subsequent date if the land is required for any scheme by CDA. Nor CDA should perpatuate illegal construction once made by the Anjuman

Faizul Islam. It was, therefore, felt that the Anjuman Faizul Islam should be advised to construct the library behind the present building on the land which is lying vacant and belongs to Anjuman and not within Islamabad right-of-way as proposed by the Anjuman. It was, therefore, decided that the Director Planning should again visit the site and give his views regarding the permission for the construction of library over the vacant land.
