The Auestion of utilization of Akhbar Market was discussed in detail and it was dedided that the shops located in the market should be licenced on individual basis on payment of rent for one year, rememble every year. The administration of hall should rest with the CDA to be rented out on occasions on payment of nominal charges. The Chairman directed that a detailed policy on the subject covering all the aspects for the administration of the whole Akhbar Market be drawn and put up for consideration of the Board in the next Executive Meeting.

3904/702/85. 298/BF-. i) SHOPS IN CLASS-III SHOPPING CENTRE WITHIN NAVAL HEADQUARTERS IN SECTOR E-8.

At the time of last auction, the plots in this shopping area were included for auction when it came to light that a number of shops already constructed on these plots were functioning. shop-keepers represented that Naval Headquarters allowed to construct these shops and that they were paying rent for these shops to the Naval authorities. These plots, therefore, had to be excluded from the auction. Negotiations were made with the Naval authorities to determine the fate of these shops, but no positive decision could be arrived at. The question of these plots have again come up during the forthcoming auction scheduled for 17-19 March, 1985. The Chairman desired that a high level meeting of the Chairman should be arranged with Naval authorities so that the matter could be thrashed out once for all. Director Estate Management should prepare a brief for the Chairman and make necessary arrangements for the meeting.
