6.1 <u>APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF MEETING OF ASC</u> <u>HELD ON 30-07-2007 AND 07-08-2007.</u>

ASC deliberated the case in detail and found the applicants eligible under Rehabilitation Policy 1996, for allotment of one agro farming plot measuring 2.5 acres in Orchard Scheme, subject to completion of all legal and codal formalities including retrieval of physical possession of acquired land to CDA.
