ITEM No. 1

Sub: LAYOUT PLAN OF MAUVE AREA SECTOR G7-1.

The Director Planning submitted the revised layout plan of the mauve area of Sector G7-1 which was approved. It was desired that the I.P.O. should now make out a proposal for the disposal of plots meant for the light service industry.

ITEM No. 2.

Sub: MODIFIED LAYOUT PLAN OF THE STAFF COLONY AT SMILY DAM.

The layout plan submitted by the D.D. (Arch.) was considered. It was suggested that another site should be selected for the proposed inspection bungalow and the two 'E' type houses should be shifted to provide space for the mosque near the shops.

ITEM No. 3.

Sub: PRELIMINARY DESIGN OF THE INSPECTION BUNGALOW.

The design submitted by the Deputy Director (Arch.) was examined and the two bed rooms provided in the bungalow were considered inadequate. It was, therefore, proposed that at least 4 bed rooms should be provided. It was decided that a revised design together with the new site of the inspection bungalow should be submitted for consideration of the Board.
