1. The design of the Blue area of sectors F-6 & F-7.

The design prepared by M/s Doxiadis Associates was discussed in depth and the following decisions were taken :-

- i) Mr. Antahopolous agreed to suggest allocation of plots for various facilities in half of the length of sectors F6/G6.
- ii) Information about the plots in the Blue area which have already been sold by the CDA should be supplied by the Director of Planning to Mr. Antahopolous. Location of plots for these functions would be fixed and other functions punctuated by the advisers.
- iii) Information available with CDA regarding the types of demands likely to accrue would be supplied by the Director Planning to Mr. Antahopolous. Thereafter the latter would supply basic necessary data to enable the CDA to advertise the sale of these plots.
- iv) Mr. Antahopolous would introduce in the design variety of forms of the secondary elements, and the primary elements would be retained as proposed by M/s Doxiadis Associates.
