The summary was considered in detail. The Board noted with concern the unfortunate position that the PG-I for the "Bulk Water Supply Scheme", which was submitted in 1962, had not yet been cleared by the BC of the NEG. It was felt that if the scheme had been sanctioned earlier the position of water supply would have been better. The Board desired that this matter should be taken up at a higher/level.

Regarding the poropsals put forward by the D.G.W. the following decisions were taken :-

- i) Instead of Shahdra Mullah the Cumrah river be tapped in the first instance, for which a proper scheme and estimates should be prepared by the N.G.W. The D.G.W. premised to complete this scheme by the end of April, 1966. It was desired that the Soan and the Korang rivers should also be tapped later so that the normal supply of water could be maintained.
- of the reservoir RL-II, for which designs and estimates should be prepared by the D.G.W.
