- 6. The Board confirmed the minutes of the 14th Board Meeting held on 20-11-2002.

Implementation

7. The Secretary CDA Board explained latest implementation status of balance decisions of 2001 and upto 12th meeting of 2002. The Board desired that details of outstanding Board decisions be conveyed to the Members/DGs. concerned for expediting their implementation and compliance report be submitted in the next Board Meeting.

- 8. The items of the agenda for the Board Meeting were then taken up. Salient points of discussion and decisions are as follows:-
 - 8.1 Conversion of Plot No. 13, G-8, Markaz, Islamabad from Cinema Plot to a plot for residential apartments.

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The Board directed that the Committee should re-examine the case keeping in view the interests of the Authority as well and a more comprehensive summary containing categorical recommendations may be brought up for reconsideration in the next Board Meeting.

8.2 Extension of 100% rebate in property tax to the minor sons & unmarried daughters in case of death of a widow entitled to 100% exemption similar to extension of pension in case of death of pensioner's widows.

8.3 Construction of 2nd carriageway of S.R. (East) F-10, Islamabad (Restoration of contract).

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- i) The case does not fall within the purview of CDA Board. It falls within the competence of Member (E) who may decide it as per rules.
- ii) Member (E) to put up a summary for the Board for insertion of additional item in the Delegation of Administrative and Financial Powers relating to revival of contract after its termination.

8.4 Restoration and waiving of restoration charges/delayed charges in respect of Quarter No. 2184-B, I-10/1-4 (CDA Colony), Islamabad.

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The penalty of Rs. 71,092.35 be condoned on humanitarian grounds and only restoration fee may be charged from him prior to restoration of quarter No.21-84-A, I-10/1-4, CDA Colony, being an ex CDA low paid employee.

8.5 Request for change of trade.

The Board directed that the Director General, Pakistan Environmental Protection Agency, may be consulted in the matter relating to marble industry as a whole and bring up a comprehensive summary containing categorical recommendations in the next Board Meeting.

\$.6 Fixation of monthly emoluments.

- In view of the Government orders contained in Finance Division's O.M. No. F.1(5)Imp/2001, dated 28-1-2002 already adopted by CDA, the incumbent was allowed fixation of pay in revised BPS-17.
- It was further decided that all the vacant posts under direct recruitment quota should be filled on regular basis after giving public notice in the press and meeting codal formalities.

8.10 The CDA (Amendment) Ordinance, 2003.

- The limitation period of appeal as well as review petition in original was approved as 30 days. Limitation period for fraud cases as 365 days from the date of detection of fraud was also approved.
- ii) The draft amending Ordinance prepared in consultation with Consultant (Law)/Legal Advisor may be got approved from the Chairman CDA before submission to the Interior Division.
