- 7. The agenda for the meeting was then taken up. Salient points of discussion and decisions were as follows:-
 - 7.1 Provision of General Truck Stand in I-11/4, Islamabad.

Decision

In view of the felt requirement of truck stand the Board decided to allocate plot Nos. 19 to 29 for the establishment of Truck Stand. It was also decided that CDA would construct the stand and manage it on contract like the bus stand in G9 Markaz. Director Municipal Administration would draw terms and conditions for the contract. DDG(W would take stes for constructing the stand, progress be reported in a months time.

7.2 Permission for construction of additional floor on commercial buildings in Islamabad

Decision

The Board decided that the Committee already constituted should review its recommendations in the light of following points emerging out of the discussion:-

- The rate of Rs. 8,300/- per square yard may be reconsidered in view of the fact that additional floor will not be used for commercial purposes but for offices or flats. For the purpose the Committee would associate the Cost Accountant.
- The permission for additional floor is likely to generate additional load on services which will have to be upgraded. The rate prescribed for granting permission should also, therefore, be able to fund the upgradation works.
- The Committee should also review their decision regarding proceedings against allottees for removal of unauthorised floors constructed by them as their demolition would be impracticable at this stage. The Committee should, therefore, reconsider their recommendations and put up the case to CDA Board for consideration and approval in fifteen days.
