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# 7.1 REGULARIZATION OF EXISTING BUILDING ON THE PLOT OF BEST WESTERN MOTEL, MURREE ROAD, ISLAMABAD.

#### DECISION

The case was discussed in detail and Board decided that the recovery of compoundable violations be made as per policy and assessment made by the Building Control. However, NOC for construction is linked with the regularization / removal of violations in set backs for which party to undertake for demolishing in a specified time. The party will have to furnish a Bank guarantee of Rs. One crore or mortgage of property of equivalent amount. The Bank guarantee will be released when the illegal construction in the set backs is demolished. The Board further decided that the amount charged from the party for violation will be examined / vetted by Member (Planning & Design) and Member (Estate) and the Committee to see that it is fair and reasonable.
