4. REDUCTION OF RENTAL VALUES IN COMMERCIAL CENTRES AND SETTING UP A WHOLE SALE MARKET IN ISLAMABAD.

On the request of the Staff Welfare Organization of the Establishment Division a summary was presented by the Secretary to the Board on reducing the rental values in commercial centres and setting up of a whole-sale market at Islamabad. The Board was requested to give its decision on the following points:

- (ii). Whether the shops of smaller size proposed to be built in Class IV Centres be run by the CDA on reasonable rents.
- (iii). Whether the use of rubber wheeled hand-driven carts by hawkers may be allowed in Islamabad.

The Board considered the proposals and decided to reject/as the acceptance of these proposals was considered to adversely effect the devalopment of the Capital City.
