Minutes of the meeting of C.D.A Board.

The Board meeting was held on Tuesday the 15th November 1988 at 10.00 A.M in the Conference Room of the Capital Development Authority. The following attended:-

- 2. The meeting started with the recitation from the Holy Quran. Thereafter the Board took up consideration of the first item of the agenda circulated on 10th November 1988. The gist of discussion reads as under:-

Representation against CBA's Orders - construction of an approach road to the rear side 98-Khayaban-e-Margalla.

Chairman explained in brief the salient features of the working paper. The position of the plot and the issue involved was also explained by the D.D.G(Planning) with the help of a site plan.

Chairman stated that since the Cabinet Division had desired that

the matter should be placed for consideration before the full CDA Board for a decision and the Wafaqi Mehtasib had also asked for a report on the subject case by 20th November 1988, hence this meeting of the Board had to be convened at a very short notice. He said that the issue before the CDA Board was whether construction of a drive-way on the part of additional land allotted to Sardar Shaukat Hayat Khan (in the name of his son and daughter) constituted a violation of the conditions on which the additional land was allotted or not. After due consideration of the pres and cons of the issue, the Board unanimously felt that the construction of drive-way on the additional land would constitute a violation of the conditions of allotment and therefore. up-held the earlier decision taken by the Authority on the application of Sardar Sahib.

3. Since both the Administrator, ICT and Commissioner, Rawalpindi had to attend to other pressing assignments in connection with "Elections", consideration of the other summary dealing with the "Illegal transfer of residential plots" included in the agenda was postponed till the next Board meeting.
